Uniform Policy 2023

Rationale

At Cefn Glas Infant School we believe that a school uniform is very important. It contributes to a sense of belonging and pride. It is practical and allows all children to fully engage with our varied curriculum, enabling them to participate safely in a range of authentic learning experiences.

In applying to attend and joining our school we ask that all children wear school uniform and we encourage them to maintain a good standard of clean and tidy dress in school at all times.

The wearing of school uniform is actively encouraged and promoted at all times and we appreciate the support of parents and carers to support us in ensuring their child is in the school uniform on a daily basis.

Please ensure you label all items with your child's name.

School Uniform

Our school colours are red, yellow and black or grey.

The uniform is as follows:-

- Red sweatshirt/cardigan/pullover
- Yellow polo shirt
- Grey/black trousers/shorts
- Grey slip/skirt
- Red check dress

There's no such thing as bad weather!

Children need to be prepared for outdoor learning. All children will need:

- A warm coat in winter / Raincoat in summer
- Wellies for outdoor learning
- Sun hat

N.B. Please make sure you apply sun cream to your child before sending them into school on sunny days.

P.E. Uniform

For Health and Safety reasons all children must be properly dressed for P.E.

The P.E. uniform is as follows and must be worn on P.E. days:

- Black shorts or joggers
- Yellow T shirt
- Trainers

Jewellery

- One pair of small stud earrings or one single small stud earring
- One watch (not a smartwatch)
- No other jewellery

N.B. Pupils must not wear earrings to school P.E. days. Please remove them at home before your child comes to school.

Hair

- Simple hair accessories (slides, ribbons, bobbles)
- No hair dye unless a celebration day, eg Red Nose Day
- No patterns cut into the hair
- No shaved heads or Mohican / Mohawk style hair cuts
- No extreme hairstyles

Make Up

- No make-up (except for medical reasons)
- No artificial nails
- No brightly coloured nail varnish or nail art

Children at Cefn Glas Infant School experience a range of hands-on learning activities, making the most of our beautiful school grounds. Your children will get muddy, they will sometimes come home wearing paint (despite our best efforts with aprons).

Labels

Please clearly label all clothes, including shoes, with your child's name. It is recommended that the name is written on the inside of the item, and not on display, for safeguarding reasons.

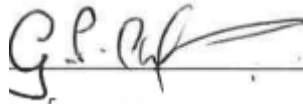
