At Cefn Glas Nursery, we want our children to feel happy, safe, and confident. Please tell staff about your child's likes / dislikes, problems or worries. The more we know about them, the happier they will feel.

An adult must bring and collect your child from Nursery. We will not let your child go with anyone we do not know, so please make sure to inform us if a different person is going to collect them.

If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea, they must not return to Nursery until they have been well for 48 hours. This is a rule that is set by the Local Health Authority.

It is school policy that we only administer medicine that is deemed life threatening, such as asthma pumps and EpiPens. For general antibiotics, a responsible adult must come to school to give the child their medicine.

Our Nursery provides a wide range of fun, active learning opportunities, both indoors and outdoors that are aimed to meet the children's individual needs,

We know that children learn best when it is exciting and relevant so we try to choose themes that we know will be of interest to them.

All these activities will enable the children to practise, develop, and acquire skills across the six areas of Learning and Experience through the Welsh Curriculum.

Preparing your child for Nursery

Your child should settle well into Nursery if they have had the experience of playing alongside other children, turn taking, working on sharing and tidying up their toys.

Please talk to them to help them understand that you will be leaving them for a little while but will be picking them up in a little while. It is also important to tell them if someone else is going to collect them.

Whilst at home, please try to read short stories regularly, sing songs, scribble, draw, colour in, chalk, complete jigsaws, count everyday objects and encourage them to talk about their activities.

Although we know there maybe odd accidents, it is important that your child is on their way to being fully toilet trained and able to wash and dry their hands.

To make it easier for your child to manage independently when they go to the toilet, we suggest that they wear a dress, jogging trousers etc without any zips or buttons.

Please help your child to recognise their own coat and practise putting it on and off themselves.

We have a school uniform which consists of:

- *Red sweatshirt or cardigan with or without the school logo
- *Yellow polo shirt with or without the school logo on
- * Grey skirt, trousers or jogging trousers

We ask that all clothes are clearly labelled with your child's name on them. Diolch!
